The big deal this month isn't planet viewing but instead to observe the stars! Some of the brightest constellations in the sky and some of the sky's most famous objects will be visible.

The constellation of Orion, the hunter, will be visible the entire month, due south after dusk. Orion has several noteworthy star objects, including the tenth brightest star in the sky that could explode sometime soon, Orion's belt and the famous "Great Nebula," M42.

Planet and Moon Highlights

- Venus, Mars, and Mercury are all in the early morning sky, near the SE horizon the entire month. On February 5th, they will be an interesting trio, somewhat close together.
- On the night of February 9th, there will be a lunar occultation! That means that the moon will appear to eclipse (to cover-up) a star.
- On the night of February 13th, the gibbous moon (that means about 3/4 full) will be close to Castor and Pollux, the two brightest stars in Gemini. This will be easy to see without any binoculars—all three in a row!
- In the early dawn of February 26th, the moon will just pass slightly below Antares, the brightest star in the constellation of Scorpius.
